- A. Consider adopting a Resolution which encourages voters to reject State Ballot Question No. 1, Amendment to the Constitution of the State (Resort Casino in West Warwick to be privately owned and operated by a Rhode Island Business Entity Established by the Narragansett Indian Tribe and its Chosen Partner), Section 1, of Article XIV of the Constitution, on Election Day, November 7, 2006.
- B. Consider adopting a resolution encouraging voters to reject state ballot question No. 9, Affordable Housing Bonds, \$50,000,000 (Chapter 246 – Public Laws 2006).
