**III. OLD BUSINESS**

- A.** DISCUSS amending recent Brayton Road traffic regulation TR2010-07 to specifically exclude school buses from the provision. If revised it would read, *“Traffic on Providence Pike (Route 5) may not enter the section of Brayton Road which runs from Providence Pike (Route 5) to Douglas Pike (Route 7), between the hours of 7:00 to 9:00 am, Monday through Friday; school buses are exempt from this provision.”*

**IV. NEW BUSINESS**

- A.** DISCUSS and CONSIDER resident's request (Kerri Oliveria, 15 Kensington Street) for regulatory signage on Kensington Street, limiting parking to one side of the roadway in the area of numbers 14 & 15.
- B.** DISCUSS road striping (temporary or permanent) on Mountindale Road S-curves between the numbers of 174 and 179 (the area commonly referred to as “flat rock”).
- C.** DISCUSS and CONSIDER regulatory signage creating parking restrictions on the east side of Lark Industrial Parkway (even-numbered side of roadway).
- D.** DISCUSS and CONSIDER regulatory signage creating parking restrictions on the Concord Street near the intersection of Putnam Pike.
