- VI. New Business
 - A. Consider non-regulatory sign installation on Indian Run Trail directing inbound school traffic *right* onto Nakomis Trail.
 - B. Consider recommending the installation of an additional street light on the utility pole at 47 Cedar Swamp Road. Property owners are stating the present illumination is still insufficient.
 - C. Discuss and consider pre-emptive traffic regulations & measures to address displaced traffic due to the Stillwater Viaduct Project (i.e., the shutting down of the bridge on George Washington Highway) along non-official detours and typical cut-through routes. *This project could begin as early as mid-March 2012 and will last until November 2012.*

1. Consider the removal / alteration of three large protruding rocks on Stillwater Road between Capron Road and Ridge Road (in the area of Sidney Street.) Although discussed in the past and determined to be not feasible, the pending increases in bi-directional traffic changes the dynamic of the situation and needed to be revisited.
2. Consider and discuss approving traffic calming measures (including speed bumps/humps) at various key locations in or around the project area as well as surrounding areas that will be impacted by the project.
 - i. These locations include, but are not limited to: Capron Road, Kane Road, Stillwater Road, Thurber Blvd., Limerock Road, Harris Road, Ridge Road, Brayton Road, Rogler Farm Road, Whipple Road, Whipple Ave, Fenwood Avenue, Whitman Street, Lincoln Street.
