



Smithfield is Talkin' Trash

Do you have something to throw away but don't know what to do with it?
The Town of Smithfield maintains guidelines for disposing of almost everything!

| ITEM | DISPOSAL OPTIONS | PREPARATION |

| Appliances | Once per month - Curbside | Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 |
| Audio Video Components | Once per month - Curbside | Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 |
| Automotive Parts | RIRRC / Junk Yard | Contact RIRRC at 942-1430 with questions |
| Carpeting / Rugs | Curbside / RIRRC | Cut in strips, rolled and secured in bundles no larger than 3 feet long by 11 inches thick for curbside collection. Larger pieces must be taken directly to RIRRC. |
| Computers | Once per month - Curbside | Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 |
| Construction Debris Demolition Material Home Improvement Waste | RIRRC / Private Contractor | The Town does not collect any roofing material, lumber, plywood, electrical fixtures, wiring, sheet rock, plaster or other material associated with construction, demolition, renovation, roofing, or household clean-out. |
| Fence | Metal - Once per month - Curbside Wood / Vinyl - RIRRC / Private Contractor | <u>Metal</u> - in rolled in bundles less than 60 pounds and less than three feet across - Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 <u>Wood / Vinyl</u> - Contact RIRRC at 942-1430 with questions |
| Furniture (interior) | One item per week - Curbside | Item must be less than 8 feet long and fewer than 60 pounds. Items that are larger than these limits must be taken directly to RIRRC. Each residence may replace one barrel of trash with one bulky item per week without special arrangements. |
| Furniture (outdoor) | Metal - Once per month - Curbside Plastic or wood - One item per week - Curbside | <u>Metal</u> - Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 <u>Plastic or Wood</u> - Item must be less than 8 feet long and fewer than 60 pounds. Items that are larger than these limits must be taken directly to RIRRC. Each residence may replace one barrel of trash with one bulky item per week without special arrangements. |
| Gas Grills | Once per month - Curbside | Propane tanks removed - Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call for an appointment at 233-1034 (See Hazardous Waste for tank disposal) |
| Hazardous Waste Chemicals | RIRRC | All Household Hazardous Waste must be disposed of at the RIRRC EcoDepot. |
| Lawn Mowers | Once per month - Curbside | All fluids must be removed - Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 |
| Logs (>4" diameter) | RIRRC / Private Contractor | Contact RIRRC at 942-1430 with questions |
| Mattress / Box Spring | One item per week - Curbside | Each residence may replace one barrel of trash with one bulky item per week without special arrangements. |
| Medications Prescription and Non-prescription | Curbside | Medications should be removed from their containers and placed loose in the trash. Medications should not be flushed down the toilet. |
| Paint | Latex - Dried out Oil based - See Household Hazardous Waste | Latex paint may be poured into a plastic bag and dried. Can may be put in the blue recycle bin and dried paint may be put in the trash. |
| Medical Sharps | Drop-off at private collection sites | Needles must be disposed of at an approved sharps collection site. Please check with your local pharmacy or doctor's office to see if sharps drop-offs are accepted. |
| Televisions | Once per month - Curbside | Make an appointment at www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm or call 233-1034 |
| Tires | RIRRC / Return to tire store | Contact RIRRC at 942-1430 with questions |
| Yard waste and Brush | Curbside / RIRRC | Yard waste in paper bags or uncovered barrel. Sticks smaller than 3" in diameter tied in bundles less than 20 pounds. See www.smithfieldri.com/recycling.htm for a current curbside collection schedule. |
