

## ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

The Town of Smithfield hereby ordains:

### Article V: ANIMAL CONTROL

#### Section 126-34. Nuisance abatement.

##### B.

It shall be unlawful to allow or permit any animal to trespass on private or public property, including but not limited to a Town-owned recreational field, so as to damage, excrete upon or destroy any property or thing of value, and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance and an offense hereunder and any such animal may be impounded by the Animal Control Warden. Whenever an animal digs, scratches, excretes upon, or causes waste or garbage to be scattered on the property of a person other than the owner of the animal, any such animal may be impounded by the Animal Control Warden.

THIS ORDINANCE AMENDMENT WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE AT THE EXPIRATION OF THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER ADOPTION.
