NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD, RHODE ISLAND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Town Council of the Town of Smithfield gives evidence of its full support of the efforts of Save the Bay in their opposition to the proposed LNG Terminal on Narragansett Bay

SECTION 2: The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to prepare a communication to Save The Bay indicating the Town Council's full support of this action.

SECTION 3: This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage by the Town Council.
